## Competitor of the Year Rules Effective for 2024

A competitor of the year award will be given at the end of the year based on the following criteria. Only individuals who have completed the eligibility requirement will be eligible for the award. The award will only be given if there is at least one individual who completes the eligibility requirements.

## Eligibility: The following requirements must be met each year to be eligible for an award

- 1. An individual must be an Indianapolis Region SCCA member by the time they check-in for their final event of the year.
- 2. A member must compete in a minimum of the following during the year for which the award is presented:
  - 1 Time Trial Event
  - 1 RoadRally Event
  - 2 Solo Events

## How to accumulate points

- 1. A maximum of 4 total events will be used to determine the total number of points. As follows:
  - 1 Time Trial Event
  - 1 RoadRally Event
  - 2 Solo Events
- 2. The points awarded will be based on the eligible competitors' highest scores from events run during the year.
- 3. Worker points will not be used in determining this award.
- 4. Points Schedule

2	9
3	8
4 through last	7

## **Determining the Competitor of the Year Winner**

1. The competitor with the highest number of points is the winner.

- 2. If there is no tie, the award will be awarded based only on the above Points Schedule
- 3. In case of a tie, the tied competitors will be awarded additional points as follows for all of the events run during the year.

Time Trials – 2 points per event RoadRally – 2 points per event Solo – 1 point per event
