Minutes of Indy Region Board Meeting

This is a synopsis of the minutes of the meeting of the Indy Region BOD November 13, 2008 at Dooley O'Tooles, 6:30 PM. There were 7 directors and 11 guests present. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Treasurers Report Rich emailed the report to everyone before the meeting. After minor discussion, the report was approved.

Old Business Steve presented the slate of nominations for 2009 Officers. The ballot will be included in the December issue of Clutch Chatter, and also sent by mail to the members who have opted-out for CC. Voting will be concluded and winners announced at the Awards Banquet and Annual Meeting January 17.

Clutch Chatter Expenses are still well within budget for this time of year. November issue was mailed on 12th. Dick asked for articles and materials for December to be submitted by Nov. 20.

Dick brought up the subject of updating our Microsoft Publisher software from version 200 to current version 2007. The board feels we can wait a little longer, as the version we have is working well for us.

Website John continues to keep the website up to date and attractive and easy to use. John will be preparing the individual awards for the banquet again this year, and asked everyone to have final season standing to him as soon as possible so he can get the awards done.

Membership Current membership is 474.

Activities Lou Byer and Chuck Hanson have set up a club activity for December 1; a nite of bench racing and fellowship at Shapiros downtown.

The 2008 Awards Banquet will be January 17 at Primo's South. Dick will have the ad with all information in the December CC, and John will have the information on the website.

Rally The November Rally had 7 cars, the best of the season. Chuck has confirmations from 3 people as Rallymasters for next year, with 2 others still possible; should

give us a full season next year.

Indy Region members Wendy Harrison and Susan Vogt won the National Championship in the Sportsman GTA category, a tremendous achievement for first year rookie members. Chuck Hanson also won the National title in the Expert Tour category.

Race We will have one race next year; a National and Restricted Regional on our traditional Mat date. Steve and Pete are trying to work the schedule to make it a full Regional and Full National, but not sure yet. Pete Hylton will be the Race Chair for 2009, with Steve Linn as assistant Race Chair.

Bryan Deane has been in contact with the GLDiv Stewards to plan a Fire and Rescue School at ORP. Bryan will work with ORP to coordinate this with their annual Fire and Rescue school, making it available to the SCCA people.

Bryan Deane has suggested we form a Competition Board to help in organizing and presenting our Race weekends. Currently, the Race Chair does everything, with what help he can get for some of the functions. With a team of people to share the loads, we should be able to make the job easier for the actual Race Chair, assigning certain functions to specific people, and relieving some of the smaller burdens. Bryan will prepare an article for the newsletter, and more information for the next meeting.

Solo Phil Wehman and Dave Dusterberg have agreed to be the Solo Co-Chairs for 2009.

The Great Lakes Divisional Race Program will be part of the SCCA National Divisional program for 2009. The 2009 Solo National Championships will be at Lincoln, Nebraska, a concrete site. We expect our car counts to increase at Grissom, and we will also have an event at Terre Haute airport, another concrete surface.

The 2009 National Tour Event will be at Grissom on July 4th weekend, we expect to host the event again.

Dave Dusterberg told us daBus needs some maintenance. Brian Gard is trying to get some shop time available to do the work.

New Business Next meeting scheduled for December 11. Meeting was adjourned.

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Region Officer Job Descriptions

To help us recruit new leaders, we present the following Job Descriptions for Region Officers. This list is by no means comprehensive, but is offered as a guide during the upcoming elections.

Regional Executive

- Chief Executive Officer of the Region.
- Official Spokesperson for the Region.
- Presides at all meetings of Members and Directors.
- Shall report on the status of the Region at each meeting.
- Shall call any special meeting of Members and Directors in accordance with the Bylaws of the Region.
- Prepares and adheres to agendas for all meetings.
- Shall appoint or discharge necessary and appropriate positions and committees.
- Shall sign and execute, together with the Treasurer (or his assignee), all contracts, notes, and drafts in the name of the Region.
- With the Treasurer, participate in creating and assist to determine the Region's budget for the coming year.
- Shall perform or cause to be performed all duties assigned to him/her by the Sports Car Club of America, Inc.
- Shall cause books, statements, reports and other certificates and records to be filed as required by law.
- Shall complete (with aid of Assistant RE) Region SCCA Charter Documents and submit to the National Office no later than February 15th of each year.
- Shall complete SCCA Directory information for the Region and submit to the National Office no later than December 31st of each year.
- Shall enforce Region's Bylaws and perform all duties incidental to the office of Regional Executive.
- Shall supervise all activities of the Region.
- Shall have other such duties and authorities as prescribed by Bylaws or Regions Board of Directors.
- Work closely with Region Board of Directors to create and monitor one year and five year plans using guidelines offered in the Mission Statement and Strategic Plan of SCCA, Inc.
- Communicate as needed with Executive Officers of other local sports car clubs, SCCA Regions, and SCCA Divisions.
- Shall maintain communications with the responsible SCCA Area Director.

Assistant Regional Executive

- Performs duties of the Regional Executive in that person's absence or incapacity.
- Performs other such duties as assigned by the Regional Executive.
- Performs duties as assigned by the Region's Board of Directors.
- Shall attend all meetings of the Members and Directors.
- With the Regional Executive, shall prepare the Region's SCCA Charter Documents and submit to the National Office no later than February 15th of each year.
- Work closely with Region Board of Directors to create and monitor one year and five year plans using guidelines offered in the Mission Statement and Strategic Plan of SCCA, Inc.

Secretary

- Shall keep minutes of meetings of Members and Directors.
- Shall be the custodian of all records of the Region.
- Shall attend all meetings of the Members and Directors.
- Work closely with the RE and Region Board of Directors to create and monitor one year and five year plans using guidelines offered in the Mission Statement and Strategic Plan of SCCA, Inc.
- Shall maintain the Region's calendar of events.
- Shall submit the Region's calendar to newsletter and website.

Treasurer

- Shall have care and custody of, and be responsible for all funds, merchandise, and assets of the Region.
- Shall have custody of monies, debts, and financial obligations of the Region.
- Shall attend all meetings of the Members and Directors.
- Reports financial status of Region to Members and Directors.
- Shall maintain accounting records in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.

- Pays listing or sanctioning fees in advance of any SCCA event.
- Shall transmit dues and income information received from the SCCA National office to the Region's Membership Chairperson.
- Shall make monthly, or more often if required, deposits to the Region's bank account.
- Obtain tax exemption certificate if required.
- With the Regional Executive, participate in creating and assist to determine the Region's budget for the coming year.
- Work closely with the RE and the Region Board of Directors to create and monitor one year and five year plans using guidelines offered in the Mission Statement and Strategic Plan of SCCA, Inc
- Shall ensure preparation and filing of tax returns in accordance with the Internal Revenue Code of the United States and other controlling jurisdictions.
- Shall notify the Region's bank(s) when changes are made with respect to addresses, signatures, and other contact information for new officers or check signers.

Membership Chairperson

- The Membership Chairperson promotes continued growth of the Region through actively recruiting new Members and retaining current Members.
- Shall be the Chairperson of the Membership Committee.
- Shall make new Members and other interested parties feel welcome at all Region events.
- Shall maintain a list of Members and other interested parties. The list shall include all available contact information.
- Shall prepare an annual Region roster.

Other Directors or Officers

- Shall attend all meetings of the Members and Directors.
- Shall perform such duties and have such powers as assigned by the Board of Directors
- Work closely with Region Board of Directors to create and monitor one year and five year plans using guidelines offered in the Mission Statement and Strategic Plan of SCCA, Inc. May be assigned as liaison to committees and specialty chiefs who are not already members of the Region's Board of Directors.

Elections for the 2009 Indianapolis Region Board of Directors will be held on Saturday, January 17, 2009 at the Annual Membership Meeting/Awards Banquet. If you have additional questions, please feel free to contact any of the current members of the Board of Directors. Contact information is on the inside front cover of the newsletter.

In addition, there are other non-elected positions of importance for the club, described below. Often, these people have also been appointed Directors each year.

Newsletter Editor

- The newsletter editor generates a periodical publication and distributes it to all Region Members and other interested parties.
- Shall produce a publication that is professional appearing and easy to read.
- Generates content that is relevant to the Region and SCCA activities.
- In cooperation with the Region's Secretary, shall generate a calendar of events.
- Shall include reports of all the Region's events.
- Shall work closely with the Region's Webmaster to ensure accuracy and timeliness of shared information and stories.
- Shall secure advertising to offset publication costs.

Webmaster

- The Region's Webmaster designs the webpage and maintains content that is relevant to the Region and SCCA activities.
- Maintains a professional and easily navigated site.
- Ensures that the website is updated on a regular basis and is timely.
- Collect stories, features, and pictures for web content.
- Works closely with the Region's newsletter editor to ensure accuracy and timeliness of shared information and stories.
- In cooperation with the Region's Secretary, shall generate a calendar of events.
- Shall include results from all of the Region's events.

INVOLVED MEMBER AWARD

The purpose of the Involved Member Award is to recognize Indianapolis Region members who exhibit exceptional participation during the year. It is not a competition between members. In fact, the more award recipients the better. It is truly a celebration of dedication, support and commitment to Indy Region SCCA.

An Involved member award will be presented to each Indianapolis Region member, 16 years of age and older, who earns a minimum of 800 points in a calendar year by participating in at least two of the following four areas of participation: meetings and other club-sponsored special events, rally, race and solo.

An Involved member award will be presented to each Indianapolis Region junior member, under 16 years of age, who earns a minimum of 400 points in a calendar year by participating in at least two of the areas of participation.

The Involved member award will be an embroidered lightweight jacket or fleece. A member will be awarded a jacket only once in every 5 calendar years (example: a winner presented a jacket in 2003 is eligible again in 2008). Repeat awards within the 5 calendar years will be recognized by embroidering of the award year on the jacket.

Points are only awarded for Indy Region related events, Great Lakes Roundtable, and SCCA National Convention. There will be no combination of points for a single event; points from only one category may be scored per day. For example, a member who is a worker and a driver on the same day at the same event may only score points for one category or the other. Each member is solely responsible for tracking and reporting their points; no one else will do this for you. To be eligible for an award, the Indy Region member must fill out the attached form or a reasonable facsimile and mail or e-mail it to the Membership Chairman. The form can also be downloaded in Excel format from our website, making tabulation of points easier. All forms must be received no later than December 31st of the year in order to be eligible for an Involved Member Award for that year. Confirming receipt of submitted points is the sole responsibility of the entrant. A person's eligibility will be verified by the Membership Chairman. The IMA will be presented to the winning members at the Annual Awards Banquet for that year.

The Rally Report: Checkpoint 11

The first year of our rebuilding effort was a qualified success with three new teams progressing to the point of taking on the responsibility of writing an event. I am pleased that two of the three have committed to doing an event for 2009. We can hope that our interpretation of the cause of the programs weakness in 2008 as due to the high gas prices was correct, and that the greatly reduced prices currently will result in increased participation in 2009. However, the overall economy is reeling to a greater extent than any of us can personally remember. We need to be prepared for another year of just holding the fort.

Building the program involves several steps. Key is developing a group of people who want to see the program continue and prosper. These will be people who enjoy drives in the country spiced up with an element of competition. The next key is a willingness to contribute. Everything about SCCA is dependent on members volunteering to help make things happen. "Somebody" has to contribute their time, and gas money, to go out and find a course that will be interesting for others to drive and write a set of instructions. Generally, this task requires several trips through the course to choose the most interesting roads and verify the instructions. It is then necessary for "somebody else" to drive the course using those instructions to validate the accuracy and safety of the event. Depending on the nature of the event, it may take several other "somebodies" on the day of the event to assist with controls (checkpoints).

It is perfectly natural to have some reluctance to step up to taking the responsibility for an event when you are basi-

cally a beginner yourself. I am prepared to assist anybody who wants to learn more about the concepts of the rally sport so that you can increase your confidence level. That assistance can include opportunities for you to either drive, or navigate, for me at out of town events such as the Champaign events, or even Divisional and National events. If you are interested, contact me about available opportunities (there really are quite a few).

I have asked several people to take the Road Rally Safety Steward Training, and intend to ask several more. I plan to offer this training in January. Road Rally Safety Stewards are the people who check events before they are offered to the public for competition; i.e. they are the "somebody else" mentioned above. If you would be interested in participating in this class (one afternoon) and I haven't asked you personally yet, please contact me. I am absolutely not attempting to exclude anybody.

Finally, I am working on a schedule for 2009. I have three volunteers for next season with two more good prospects. I am planning to write at least one personally, and maybe as many as three. I would rather spend the time helping you write an event so that we have more available "somebodies." The value of this is that it is no longer necessary to depend on the same people to write events every year, allowing them to "relax" and just compete. It also helps avoid "burnout" which is a major factor in losing people from the program.

Given the climate of change that is occurring in our own region and nationally as well I am proposing a change of sorts that I believe will contribute to growing the Road Race Division of our club. I am proposing the creation of a Road Racing Comp Board to oversee and guide the program going forward.

The main purpose of the board is as follows:

- 1) To recruit, train, develop and support a pool of members to act as Race Chairs for our events. To conduct official Pre and Post Race meetings to evaluate the programs level of success while working to improve the product for all.
- 2) Provide overall guidance; assist in writing Supplemental Regulations for the Road Racing Program.
- 3) To create a conduit for competitors, officials and crew to express their ideas and concerns regarding the Road Race Program. And to develop new ideas for the Race Program.
- 4) To seek out and consider new venues, partnerships and concepts to expand the Road Race program.
- 5) To undertake, evaluate and develop other projects associated with the Road Race Program as directed by the Board of Directors.

This body should be comprised of the following members:

- A) The Senior Steward of the Region
- B) The Chief of F&C
- C) The Chief of T&S
- D) The Chief of Tech
- E) The Chief of Registration
- F) The Chief of Start
- G) The RE or Asst. RE
- H) The Chief of Pit & Grid (which includes Paddock)
- I) 1 Driver Representative
- J) The Race Chair(s) – for their event only.

This is a concept that I have seen work in other regions successfully and it helps have a ready pool of talent available for the program and keeps the responsibility for our race program from being a permanent assignment for one or two people to the point they burn out or no longer have the time to devote to the Race Program. The benefit is that we are developing new talent that hopefully will also step in to contribute in other ways to the growth and success of the region.

This change is being proposed with an eye to the future and the continued growth of our Road Race Program.

This proposal is for the Region's consideration and if approved should become active with the incoming Board of Directors.

I will have more to come after the holidays on the Flag & Fire School which was proposed to the division, by me, so stay tuned! Until then Happy Holidays to all!

To qualify for the program, the new member may not have been an SCCA member in the previous 18 months.

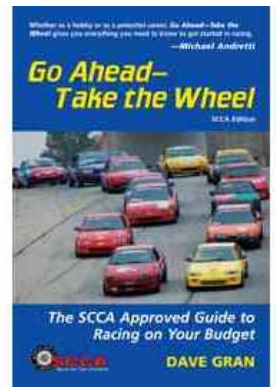
In order to receive credit for referring a new member, the recruit must provide your name and membership number when they sign up. This may be done via SCCA.com (preferred), phone, fax or mail.

FOR SALE: Small Car Trailer

Homebuilt from the 1960's, for a small car. I bought it from a fellow that was carrying a Lotus 7, and I used it for several years to carry a 1975 Honda Civic sedan, that we ran in stock class soloing, going all over CenDiv and several trips to Kansas. I also carried a Triumph TR-4 on it to local events. Later I used it to carry my solo vee, when the wide tires would not fit on the vee trailer.

Trailer also has original other heavier fenders (these fenders were made so could put wider car on trailer.) It has three 13 inch wheels and tires, and also has 3 15 inch rims for carrying heavier cars. It is a heavily made steel frame, has several coats of paint from over the years. I put the axle and springs under it in the 1970's. The springs were a weight capacity of 2800 pounds. It is a sturdy little trailer, but has no brakes, that pulls very well. Lights worked last time used, and the wiring is pulled thru plastic tubes for better weather protection.
