The all-Japanese team unfortunately retired in the 82nd hour, but the other car driven by a Belgian team went on to take 4th place. This was a surprise to everyone, especially for a new team with new engine technology (6). In 1969 the team brought two Familia Rotary Coupes to the Spa 24 hours endurance race. Mazda yet again surprised everyone by finishing fifth and sixth behind 4 Porsche 911's (1). Over the next decade "Mazda Sports Corner" campaigned various Mazdas all over the world.

1978 brought the introduction of the RX-7, which proved to be one of the most successful Mazdas both on and off the track. The RX-7 would go on to win 100 races over the next 12 years They realize that the majority of the money in motorsports is in the International Motorsports Association Series or IMSA.
