Indianapolis Region/SCCA April 2018 Board Meeting Minutes

The April 2018 board meeting of the Indianapolis Region/SCCA was held at Donato's Pizza in Brownsburg on April 10, 2018. Those in attendance: Dick Powell, Raleigh and Velma Boreen, Bruce and Sue Faucett, Lee and Reba Miller, Colin Faucett, Gwen Faucett, Catherine Justiniano, Sam Crites, Charles Hanson, Matt Adams, Chris and Stefanie Brake, Wendy Harrison, Kyle Cooney, Sarah Finnerty, Michael Young and Daniel Froemming. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 by RE Chris Brake.

A motion was made by Wendy, seconded by Bruce to approve the March board meeting minutes. The motion passed.

#### **Old Business**

Bruce has been checking for a new meeting place in the Speedway area but with no luck. The hunt will continue Stefanie passed out the new board shirts with the Indy Region logo embroidered on them. Distinctive color so it will be easy to identify board members at gatherings.

Colin will be going to Mallow Run to verify date for the 2019 year end banquet and to make a deposit to hold the date.

#### Website

The website has been updated with the results from the Track Event this past weekend at Putnam Park.

#### **Clutch Chatter**

Maggie will be getting the Clutch Chatter out soon. The question about the software she is using was brought up and the software is good. Bruce suggested that the Great Lakes Solo Series events be published in the Clutch Chatter as well.

#### **Membership**

Matt reported that our membership is at 525. There were 9 new members added. Michael picked up 2 new members at the Track Event. Matt will continue to put anniversary dates in the Clutch Chatter.

#### Treasurer's Report

Colin reported that we have money and that some of the funds from the Track Event have already come in. The balance should be posted in the next week or so.

#### **Activities**

The last indoor karting event for the season has happened. The trophies for that series have been ordered.

#### Social Media

Chris did some paid marketing on social media and some good hits came from doing that. When paid ads are used, 3-4,000 people see the ads. Chris had social media decals made and they were available at the meeting to anyone that wanted them – in a rainbow of colors! Chris would also like to have signs in grid at the Solos that say – "Share your experience with Indy SCCA". Wendy asked about doing an ad for the Rally coming up. Chris suggested that she get something to Vinnie about a month prior to the event, including a graphic, 4 sentences and then a link to the event.

Solo

The first event was held at Grissom April 7-8 with the Purdue students (PAPA), with 48 people there on Saturday and 34 on Sunday. Purdue pays for the insurance, porta-johns and a \$50 service fee to Indy Region. The rest of the funds go to the Wounded Warrior charity. This year \$1120 went to the Wounded Warriors. Three new members signed up. Our next events are April 14-15 at Grissom. Saturday is the dragcross and Sunday is a fun event.

There is a novice driver's school on May 5<sup>th</sup>, also at Grissom. Will Lahee is the chair for the school. May 6<sup>th</sup> will be Indy Region's first points event.

May 19<sup>th</sup> is the Midwest Muscle Car event in Terre Haute. Dave Dusterberg is heading up that event. Contact him if you are interested in helping.

#### Rally

Wendy has the Rally for June 23<sup>rd</sup> set. It will end near Victory Field and the entry for the Rally will also include 2 adult entries to the baseball game that evening. Discussion ensued about the entry fee and it was decided to keep it at \$20 per car. If a car has more than 2 people in it and everyone wants to go to the game, it is the responsibility of those people to pay for tickets for the game. The Rally starts at 4:00 at Eagle Creek and will end about 5:30 near the ballpark. Wendy will post a link.

Workers are also needed for the July National event on July 7<sup>th</sup>. Wendy will ask Ted to push this on social media. Anyone who works the Rally on July 7<sup>th</sup> will get a free entry into the event the following day, July 8<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Track Events**

Michael reported that he had 43 entries for the Track Event but 5 cancelled the night before because of pending weather conditions. Because of this, the cancellation policy will be changed. People who ran the first Track Event were given a voucher for \$50 off on the next event. Michael is working on making people feel more important and to make sure that they are enjoying themselves. Lunch and dinner were provided for everyone. He wants to make sure that everyone there feels very welcome. People stayed around to watch the Time Trials so that was very encouraging. Michael is also talking with a sponsor. In return, the sponsor will be given free entries into that event to use how they see fit. He is also going to check with Chris at Putnam to make sure that signage can be put up during the event if the sponsorship comes through.


#### **New Business**

This would give him plenty of time to get the wearable item to the embroiderer and then back to the member at the banquet in January.

It was also discovered that members participating in Track Events were not able to count those events towards the Involved Member points. This was an omission in the bylaws. A motion was made by Matt, seconded by Daniel to add Track Events to the Involved Member points system. The motion passed.

With no further business, the next meeting will be on May 8<sup>th</sup> at Donato's in Brownsburg. The meeting was adjourned at 7:34 pm.
