Approval of February Minutes – Approved Old Business –

Discussed alternate monthly meeting sites and region shirts. Both projects are ongoing. Suggestion to ask for the membership for design ideas for the region shirts to be sold at events. Website - Via e-mail "First off thanks so much for all the help in sending me stuff to update the site for each of the programs. I think we have pretty much everything except any updates to any rules which have not been sent to me yet. Also, a reminder to please send me information to be posted on the site. We still have some items that seem to just get posted to Facebook or only sent to the Clutch Chatter for me to discover. I think it important to put everything in as many places as possible to allow our members to have several ways to get that information. So, I would most appreciate sending me an email and letting me get that info posted for you."

Clutch Chatter - March edition looked great! Idea for future issues to have the SCCA anniversaries listed each month with a short interview of one of the anniversary members. *Membership* – Via e-mail "February looked to have better outreach from the national office on membership renewals - many more were already registered than not. January, I understand was particularly bad based on feedback the Boreens got when they called. So, the numbers are 549 total, 4 new. National Convention does not appear to conflict with this date currently. They are asking for a small fee in addition to this year. Motion to increase the banquet budget was motioned by Colin/Joel and approved.

Activities – One more event in the karting league. 28 at the last event. Social Media – Starting boosted posts for the first track event. Solo -Training day this Saturday from 11am-4pm. Training for Solo Safety Steward, Junior Driver (kart) Steward, Timing and Scoring, and Tech. First event will be us helping with the PAPA charity autocross for the Wounded Warriors on April 7-8. CAM Challenge and the May Test n Tune events could both use volunteers to staff these events.

Rally – The June 23rd social rally that will start at Eagle Creek and end downtown for an Indian's baseball game has a rally theme! Flyers for the rally will be out by the next board meeting. Starting to promote the National Rally in July. Workers for the July 7th National Rally will get a free entry into the July 8 th Divisional Rally. 12 workers needed for the National Rally.

Track Events – Three weeks to the first event. Need workers to staff grid and registration. 15 have already registered! Worker driving sessions will be worked in during the normal event this year. Discussion of the
