(Conversations with Indy Region Members and other significant SCCA members with Raleigh Boreen)

This week's conversation is with John Clyne.

John currently lives in Zionsville and other than four years in Lafayette, IN. while at Purdue, he has lived in the Indianapolis area all of his life. I got to sit down and chat with John in early December about the club.

#### How long have you been a member of SCCA?

I joined Indy Region after going to a Starting Line SCCA Drivers school at the Tire Rack in 2016. I took the school in my daily driver, a Mini Cooper and was hooked on doing driving events. I tried a Track Night in America and went to a National Solo in 2017, I was absolutely hooked.

#### What activities do you participate in with Indy Region?

Currently I am driving a Mustang GT in CAM C at the Solo events and I am working to help the Region with Rookie walks at Solo events and co-chairing the CAM Challenge. I have had the Mustang a couple of years and won the 2020 Indy Region Year End Championship in CAM C.

#### How did you get interested in cars and the SCCA?

I have always loved cars. In college my daily driver was a 1985 Merkur XR4TI. It had a lot of performance for the time. It was a 4cyl Turbo car. You did not see a lot of them and finally the maintenance caught up with me. I also loved Go Karts and bought a truck to haul my Go Kart around. I was involved with the Purdue Gran Prix while I was in college. Today I have a Mini and my Mustang so I can have some fun.

#### What would you like to see Indy Region do in 2021 and coming years?

I would love to be able to help the club find some more Solo sights in the Indy metro market. Grissom is great but I think if we found some more local sites the club would really grow. I enjoy helping with the Time Trial and am excited to see that program grow.

#### Outside of SCCA, what is something you really enjoy doing?

I am very involved with my 13-year-old son. He is very active in the Robotics Club at his school so I am involved as a helper and a judge for events. Work, family and the SCCA keep me very busy, but I am enjoying what I do very much.

Dayle is the newest member of the SCCA Board of Directors from the Great Lakes Division. Indy Region is part of the Great Lakes Division of the SCCA. He has spent time in Illinois, Oklahoma, and Arkansas before moving to Michigan in 1990. He and his wife Melinda have lived there ever since.

#### How long have you been a member of SCCA?

I have been a member of SCCA since 1997 but I have been around SCCA since I was a little boy. My father was a member of SCCA for 50+ years starting in the late 50's.

#### What activities do you participate in with SCCA?

I started working races as a corner worker and it pit/grid back in the 80's at Hallet in Oklahoma. I wanted to know everything I could about tracks, what kind of cars were good to race and trying to pick people's minds to see what it took to race. I started Road racing in 2001. I Road raced until 2017 and then I sold my HP Sprite in 2020. I current work races again and Solo my Chevy Bolt EV in H/Street.

#### How did you get interested in cars and the SCCA?

As I said my father was an SCCA member for many years. He worked at Argonne National Labs near Chicago in the late 50's and 60's with people from Europe. Many of them had sports cars and he got the itch for MG's, Jaguars and the like. He bought his first Lotus Super 7 in 1962. I followed suit and when I was old enough started working races and doing anything I could to be around race cars. I mentioned I Solo a Chevy Bolt. I had one of the first ones when they came out in 2017. It has been one of the most fun cars I have ever owned and one of the most affordable.

#### What would you like to see Great Lakes Division do in 2021 and coming years?

My main reason for wanting to be on the SCCA Board of Directors is better communication. # <u>Notes from the Director's Chair</u> <u>Area 4 Director Update for February, 2021</u>

January was a busy month. As I mentioned in last month's update, in addition to the BoD meetings, I also sit in on the Club Racing Board (CRB) and Rally Cross Board (RXB) meetings. There were BoD meetings on 1/11 and 1/25 as well as a CRB meeting on 1/5 and RXB meetings on 1/12 and 1/19. I also sat in on a couple of regional meetings doing an "Ask the

Director" session with them. Throw in the SCCA Convention sessions that I attended (five on 1/23 and several more during the rest of the convention) and there was a lot of time spent on video conference sessions.

The BoD meetings were fairly mundane in that we dealt with a lot of boring, procedural stuff. We go over financial reports and other miscellaneous items. For example, we're getting a new board management platform in the next few months. This is a web based, software package that will help us vote, manage meetings, post agendas, etc. Really interesting stuff, huh? We're also trying to coordinate a face to face meeting at some point once the pandemic gets quenched a bit. As you can imagine, we're all pretty busy during the competition season and finding a suitable date has been pretty tough. Yes, there are some super-secret, hush-hush details that I cannot mention here but I will tell you that most of that isn't nearly as interesting as you might imagine.

The CRB meeting was pretty long (3.25 hours) and they discussed a whole myriad of rules and policy changes. The RXB folks discussed policies for expanding RallyX's footprint. I must say that I really enjoy attending these sessions as it reiterates how much passion there is for our sport across all the disciplines SCCA covers.

I've been working on a few other things too:

- 1. I've started talking with more regions about sitting in on their regional meetings. I have a couple of them already scheduled and am willing to do some more.
- 2. I've been working with the various divisional stewards about our event schedules. I am REALLY interested in going to a bunch of events this summer. I've penciled in a visit to GingerMan to watch/work the Time Trials National Tour in July (7/16-7/18). I also hope to go to at least one of the Pro Solo events. I've attended and participated in a few Solos over the years, but they've always been of the regional variety. Seeing a Pro Solo will be eye opening I'm sure. I also want to make sure I get to a Road Rally event this summer.
- 3. I've been working with our webmaster on a complete reworking of our divisional website. It'll look fantastic once it's done.
- 4. I've been working with Val McCammon, Velma Boreen and Tony Brown on the GLDIV Spring Training meeting. If you haven't done so already, please respond to Val's emails for guidance on what the divisional membership would like to get out of this virtual meeting.

That about sums up January of the BoD for me. 24 hours in front of my PC screen on video conferences and a bunch more wrestling with "all things Area 4". I'm slowly getting into the waters (more than "dipping my toes", less than "up to my neck"). I'm sure the pace will increase as the club maneuvers around Covid-19 in the next few months.
