V. Membership

- a. Membership Report was e-mailed to all by Dustin Hitze.

VI. Activities

- a. Ethan Decatur needs more coaches regarding the Tire Rack Survival scheduled for Saturday, April 25, 2026 at Lincoln Tech parking lot. He would like for anyone intending to take the Tire Rack Coaches Course on line to do so by Thursday, April 23. Ethan will print schedule of events. He would like club members to bring their cars to the event, Paving activities will not interfere. Wendy to provide classroom instructions.
- b. The solo event bus is at Dave Currey's house for clean up. He may not be able to attend TRSS event.
- c. An event at IMS is possible on June 20, 2026 for club participation and recruitment activities as well as a celebration of the Club's 80th anniversary. Discussions are ongoing with IMS for a hospitality room on Saturday, June 20 for a six hour period. The event will coincide with a car show at Trans-Am/SVRA/Speed Tour/Formula 4 at IMS on that date. 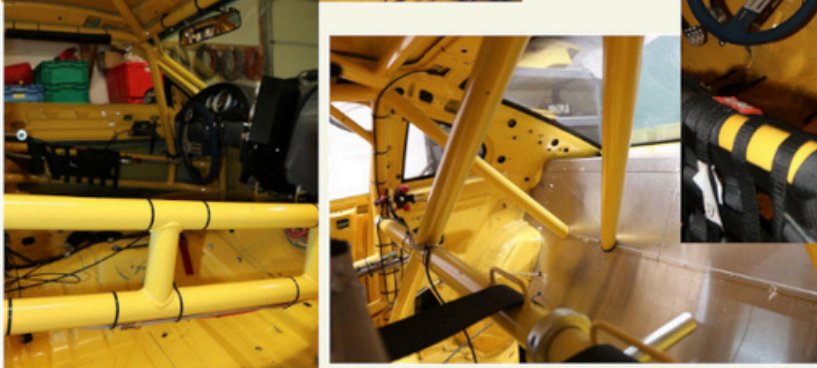
